To that end, they shall: comply with all relevant laws, including, but not limited to, the Bribery Act 2010; not take any action or permit the taking of any action by a supplier or third party which may render WH Smith liable for a violation of any relevant law; not use money or other consideration paid by WH Smith for any unlawful purposes, and; upon request, be required to have their own subcontractors, consultants, agents or representatives execute a similar written anti-corruption compliance statement, and to confirm to WH Smith that such action has been taken.
